



Alameda Soccer Club Islanders **Tryout Notification 2018**

Following tryouts players/families will be notified between the end of tryouts and June 3 regarding if the player has been selected for one of our Competitive Teams. Some age groups may take longer than others due to number of players at tryouts, make-up tryouts, and team formation logistics. Every effort will be made to form as many teams as possible within an age group or age group span by matching the skill-level of players.

Players will be contacted either through email or phone call by the Head Coach or Competitive Teams Coordinator. At that time players will be notified as to which team they have been offered a spot and what Competitive Program Level that team will be at within our club. We ask that players reply within 24 hours if they would like to accept/decline a roster spot on the team they have been selected for. Within an age group an Alameda SC “Red” team (1st team) will be filled first, then “White” (2nd team), and “Blue” (3rd team). The process can take several days to notify all players on all teams. Any player that we are not able to offer a roster spot to will be notified at the end of this process.

Once a player commits to joining the team, the player agrees to abide by the rules, policies and regulations of the club and the team. Players/parents will be asked to sign and return a Player-Parent Contract confirming that they will be playing on the team on which they were selected to play. Once the player commitment letters are signed, players are expected to honor that commitment and the agreements outlined in the contract. Please take into account the fact that when a player makes a commitment to play for an Islanders team, the coach may need to inform other potential players that they did not make the team. Please be sensitive to others and consider the decision to play at this level carefully.

Registration and payment of fees for the 2018-19 Competitive Season will open on Team Snap on June 1. Players are expected to register by June 15 to avoid a late fee. Payments for the season may be paid in installments through Team Snap. Financial assistance is also available and can be applied through our Scholarship Form on the ASC website.
